Reporting Procedures for Club Members

One of the aims of the Ware SC Committee is to provide a safe and fun environment for all club members. However, should any member wish to raise a concern relating to abuse (physical, sexual, emotional) or neglect. The following options are available to you:

Option 1

You can speak in confidence to the Club's Welfare Officer who will offer advice to resolve your concern in line with the Amateur Swimming Association reporting procedures.

Ware SC's Welfare Officer is Anne Vanner.

Option 2

You can contact the ASA SwimLine on 0808 100 4001.

SwimLine is for anyone involved in swimming. SwimLine calls are free and do not appear on itemised bill unless the call is made from a mobile phone.
